Subject: Funding Request To Conduct Oral History Interviews of City of Indian Wells Change Agents and Leaders by Lawrence de Graaf Center for Oral and Public History, CSU - Fullerton

2023 is the banner year for reorganization and revitalization of the Indian Wells Preservation Foundation (IWPF) in championing new ideas, establishing compelling new events and pursuing new opportunities to preserve and celebrate the City's history.

Indian Wells Oral History Project:

One expeditiously proposed opportunity is *The Indian Wells Oral History Project* in accordance with the Lawrence de Graaf Center for Oral and Public History. The Center was established in 1968 as a teaching, training, research, publication, and public service archive located at CSU Fullerton's Pollak Library. It contains more than 6,000 oral histories covering a wide range of people and topics from California and beyond.

At its outset, the project is dedicated to interviewing 10 City galvanizers and change agents including Raymond Moore (Tennis icon/BNP Paribus), Richard Oliphant (Community developer/civic leader), Adele Ruxton (pioneer IW historian/60 year resident), Joe Williams (IWGR Director of Golf/began 1996) and six other diverse contributors who have shaped the storied City of Indian Wells.

Budget:

Detailed description of \$25,000 budget for 10 interviews is attached. Faculty appointed from CSUF Lawrence de Graaf Center for Oral and Public History will conduct the project and provide outcome products. IWPF Board will oversee and monitor the project. Detailed project timeline to be provided May 15, 2023.

Timeframe:

Pending spring 2023 budget approval and disbursement of funding, project begins June 2023, concludes October 2023, final products ready for divergent presentations November – December 2023, including IWPF Annual Meeting.
