**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF INDIAN WELLS, CALIFORNIA,
IDENTIFYING POSITIONS AUTHORIZED TO SIGN CITY
WARRANTS AND OUTLINING THE PROCEDURES THEREOF**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Indian Wells finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the City and its financial controls to designate specific positions authorized to sign City warrants and to establish the procedure thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to repeal prior Resolution No. 91-65 and replace it with the current direction consistent with sound financial practices; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDIAN WELLS DOES
HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. City warrants shall require two (2) signatures, which shall consist of the City Manager and the Finance Director. No other City officials or employees are authorized to sign City warrants.

SECTION 2. The signatures identified in Section 1 may be applied using secure electronic or authorized facsimile signatures, consistent with current banking procedures and internal controls.

SECTION 3. The City of Indian Wells Resolution No. 91-65 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
